Road Closures begin at 6:30am and will reopen on a rolling basis until approximately 9:15am.
Downtown streets may not reopen until 10:00am.

RED AVOID = Race Course – you will NOT be able to cross/use these streets during the race without delays
GREEN = EXIT ROUTE DURING RACE

South of Rosecrans – best to exit South using Hermosa Ave to 15th Street, Right to Manhattan Ave and left on Manhattan Beach Blvd to Hermosa Ave.

North of Rosecrans - exit using Highland to Grand Ave, El Segundo prior to 7:50am
